

El último tributo



An anthology of songs and travel stories by **Santiago Auserón** on guitar and in voice format.

One of the references of Spanish pop-rock and singer of the legendary band Radio Futura visits us exclusively at our festival. Santiago Auserón shows us his mixture of stage characters of Iberian minstrel, bluesman and sonar. In his solo concerts, accompanied by his guitar, he produces a show rich in dimensions and nuances. The songs follow each other like a production made up of travel scenes.

In his latest compositions, lyrics and melodies surprise once again for their originality.

Returning to the bare musical format, they regain the freshness of the first sketches, which then evolved into a mature musical armour.

Santiago Auserón presents his songs with improvised stories that combine lyricism and humour, sharing innovative ideas. His loyal audience has gradually become a kind of brotherhood with no rules other than the shared experience of poetry and music.

A night of Catalan pop-rock with two of our country's most iconic bands. A fantastic night in a magical place such as the Dalmau Park.

Mishima will present their latest album L'aigua clara "Clear Water" (TRIS, 2022), with live music, a cluster of sensations halfway between communion and catharsis. David Carabén (vocals and guitar), Marc Lloret (keyboards), Dani Vega (guitar), Xavi Caparrós (bass) and Alfons Serra (drums). From the format of short distance from the public, they remain faithful to the close contact format with the spectators, offering a repertoire that is already history.

Quimi Portet brings us If it rains, we will do it at the Pavilion World Tour, title of the new double live album that he published at the end of 2020: the first live album of his career and also his first compilation of "greatest hits" (with two unreleased tracks). Recorded throughout the course of several concerts during the 2018-2019 World Tour with a power trio completed by Jordi Busquets (guitar) and Ángel Celada (drums), this beautiful music illustrates the transmutation into a genre in itself of an artist who, beyond the millions of records sold with Los Burros, Los Rápidos and El Último de la Fila, has never stopped being faithful to his own universe.

ALBA CARMONA Flamenco

Cantora

A student of roots music, Alba Carmona has moved for years between the sounds of popular music and modern music. She has stepped onto countless stages around the world and recorded albums with artists such as Perico Sambeat, Carlos Saura, Chano Domínguez, Las Migas, Maurici Sotelo or Miguel Poveda.

Alba presents her second album *Cantora*, a tribute to popular songs and to the richness and personality of these songs. People sing and dance to have fun, but also as a ritual, as a belief and as an ideological conception, as a claim and a complaint, as a manifestation of love...

This show starts with traditional Spanish music and flamenco, and travels to various places in the world where the soundscapes are transformed whilst keeping all these essences in common. Andean, Ibero-American and Spanish songs brought to a more contemporary and current reading lead us into this raw and exciting concert in which the voices, the guitar, the violin and the percussion will be the vehicle that transports us to the roots of the music.

IRIE SOULJAH + HUG

Reggae & rock

Irie Souljah is the stage name of Pep Grau from Calella, artist, singer and producer of international renown in the world of reggae and Jamaican music, with a decade of experience touring Europe, the United States and Central America, and performing in the most prestigious festivals of the genre. His first album, *Immigrant*, did not leave anyone indifferent. Nominated for best new reggae artist at the Caribbean Music Awards, the artist from Calella has recently signed a contract with the American label Ineffable Music, possibly the most important reggae label in the United States, with which he has already released his second project called All About Love, an EP with more musical nuances and touches of Afro Beat, Dancehall and R&B.

Hug is the new musical project of Hugo Nubiola, a multi-instrumentalist musician from Sant Pol de Mar. After a three-year break in the creative field since the dissolution of the Imperial Jade group, Hugo Nubiola returns to the scene with a project of his own. Hug's music is personal and introspective; he composes, self-produces and records almost all the instruments of his songs with the aim of showing us his vision of the world. Hug's music comes from very diverse influences: from blues and jazz to classic pop and rock, passing through folk and psychedelia. This summer, for the first time, he presents his first LP in band format, with members of Imperial Jade.

CHANO DOMÍNIGUEZ & MARIOLA MEMBRIVES



Membrives is a natural union between two artists who share the restlessness of research and creation from common references such as flamenco, jazz, folklore and song. The pianist from Cádiz, now resident in New York, is the most recognized international exponent, twice nominated for the Latin Grammys, for bringing jazz and flamenco together in the most natural and organic way.

Mariola Membrives, for her part, has emerged as one of the most revealing voices of recent times. Trained as an actress and singer, she became known on the music scene with the publication of her album *Llorona* a duo with the Japanese double bass player Masa Kamaguchi who has aroused admiration and enthusiasm for his participation in the *FreeBach* shows by La Fura dels Baus and Federico García by Pep Tosar.

The duet premiered at the Grec amphitheater in Barcelona as the opening concert of the *Mas i Mas Festival*. His repertoire includes pieces by Thelonious Monk, Atahualpa Yupanqui, Marta Valdés, Victor Young and Violeta Parra

MOMO, TRIBUTE TO QUEEN



With the deep knowledge of his musical legacy, the musician **Momo Cortés** from Extremadura was chosen by Brian May himself to star in the Spanish version of the musical *We Will Rock You*. In an explosion of strength, power and pure rock the repertoire consists of Queen's greatest hits, as well as some not so well-known British songs.

A Momo concert is a heartfelt tribute to the essence of Queen. A journey from the beginnings of the legendary British group in the 70s, reviving their character, those early days of Glam. The gorups influence on hard rock, the psychedelia and personal and particular way of understanding rock, when the leather "chupa" ruled the streets, until reaching the Queen of the 80s.

Roger Padròs is a singer, composer and pianist. With the publication of his first EP *Mil más*, the opportunity appeared to be part of the seventh edition of La Voz, where after a long journey he reached the finals. Soon came the first album *La vida és millor*, with a great reception from the public. And now he presents his second album *A contrallum*, like an awakening to adulthood, when you start to see the light and dark of the world around you.

A work of personal and musical introspection to capture that what really motivates us is what gets under our skin and moves us. Each song is a photograph of a situation or a feeling. Grief, happiness, friendship, trust, self-esteem, memories or the passage of time are some of the themes that the songs explore.

Roger Padrós strives to take singer-songwriter music to another level, talking about important issues in the social and cultural sphere, through personal, fresh songs and a diversity of styles which offer us a very good live performance.

A contrallum is both light and shadow, but above all, it is how we feel human.








Transport times of the little train *Carrilet* to the Lighthouse

For reasons beyond the organization's control, the schedule may be altered. If this were the case, notification will be given via social networks and Radio Calella and an email will be sent with the possible changes.


It is recommended to arrive at least half an hour before each performance in order to make the entry as staggered as possible.
